Each backpack should be labeled "boy" or "girl", noting the age group. A **royal blue** (or similar) ribbon indicates a **boy's backpack**. A **pink** ribbon indicates a **girl's backpack**. A second ribbon indicates age:

ITEMS TO COLLECT: Each zippered school backpack should include:

- 1) **NEW CLOTHING:** 3 to 5 items such as winter hats, gloves, socks, scarfs, etc.
- 2) **SMALL POP-TOP CANS OF FOOD:** such as ravioli, tuna, beef stew, fruit (3-4 cans). Please, nothing that will crush, or plastic containers of food.
- 3) **NEW, AGE-APPROPRIATE TOYS**: 2 or 3 toys. Examples are small cars, balls, dolls, small stuffed animals, yo-yos, jump rope, sidewalk chalk, Slinky, card games, Legos, etc. (No toy weapons, please!) For the older youth category, substitute an appropriate item for toy. (No pocketknives.) If you send a toy that needs batteries, please install the batteries and send extras.
- 4) **HYGIENE ITEMS**: Toothpaste, toothbrush, soap, washcloth, brush/comb, shampoo, deodorant, lotion, and other appropriate items. Please fit items into a one-gallon Ziploc bags ,so they will not leak.
