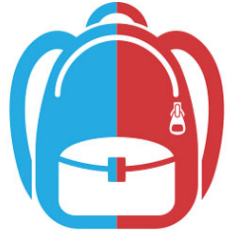

Churches working together, seek to meet the physical and spiritual needs of people living in Boone County, West Virginia through **Appalachian Christmas Backpacks**.

GOAL and COLLECTION DATE:

Our goal is to collect **1,000 backpacks** filled with items to be distributed to children in December. The collection day for Habersham and Liberty Associations is November 2-3 from 8:00 AM to Noon or November 5 from 9-10:00 AM at Clarkesville Baptist Church. Please call the church at 706-754-2643 before delivering your Christmas Backpacks. We encourage churches to begin collecting and filling the backpacks early—and throughout the year.

AGE GROUPING and LABELING:

Each backpack should be labeled “boy” or “girl”, noting the age group. A **royal blue** (or similar) ribbon indicates a **boy’s backpack**. A **pink** ribbon indicates a **girl’s backpack**. A second ribbon indicates age:

Age Group	Color of Ribbon	Age Group	Color of Ribbon
4-7	Yellow	11-14	Red
8-10	Green	15-17	White

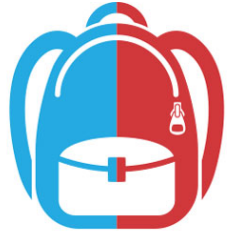
ITEMS TO COLLECT: Each zippered school backpack should include:

- NEW CLOTHING:** 3 to 5 items such as winter hats, gloves, socks, scarfs, etc.
- SMALL POP-TOP CANS OF FOOD:** such as ravioli, tuna, beef stew, fruit (3-4 cans). Please, nothing that will crush, or plastic containers of food.
- NEW, AGE-APPROPRIATE TOYS:** 2 or 3 toys. Examples are small cars, balls, dolls, small stuffed animals, yo-yos, jump rope, sidewalk chalk, Slinky, card games, Legos, etc. (No toy weapons, please!) For the older youth category, substitute an appropriate item for toy. (No pocketknives.) If you send a toy that needs batteries, please install the batteries and send extras.
- HYGIENE ITEMS:** Toothpaste, toothbrush, soap, washcloth, brush/comb, shampoo, deodorant, lotion, and other appropriate items. Please fit items into a one-gallon Ziploc bags, so they will not leak.
- FRESH, WRAPPED CANDY:** Please, no chocolate, as it may melt—and no peanut products due to allergies.
- AGE-APPROPRIATE SCHOOL SUPPLIES:**
- AGE-APPROPRIATE BIBLE:** No particular version is required.
