<u>Ephesians 2:10</u> - "For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus unto good works, which God hath before ordained that we should walk in them."

In looking back over the past associational year (October thru today) and celebrating the highlights and evaluating our growth needs I am reminded of this verse in Ephesians 2:10. You and I are intended by God Himself to work for Him. We are called to those works (not saved by them!). He wants us in our churches and this association to display His Glory ("let your light so shine that they may see your good works and glorify your Father who is in heaven" – Matt. 5:16) Here are some of the highlights.....

Highlights of Ministry From This Year....

<u>Christmas Backpacks</u> - Again, this was a great year with our area combining with Habersham and Rabun Associations to collect <u>well over a thousand backpacks</u> that blessed the school children of West Virginia and Sevierville, Tennessee. We are again packing those bags for this year.

<u>Evangelism Conference (Cummings)</u> – We had several churches participated in the GBMB Evangelism Conference this past year with great fellowship and teaching. We look forward to the next one.

<u>Executive Committee Meetings</u> - were held at several locations through the past year with a low numbers of members present. Remember that your church can send representatives to this meeting to help with planning and evaluating what is happening in the association.

<u>LBA/HBA VBS Training @ Antioch</u> - In April we conducted an excellent VBS preparation training event led by four of our leaders from both associations! They did an excellent job and then many churches reported having active VBS events this past summer!

Mission Judea w/ Columbus Baptist - Starting the last week of June going through the third week of July multiple teams of missionaries from various Columbus Area Baptist churches came into our area helping to carry out vacation bible schools, church planting, backyard bible clubs, revivals and outreach. They also worked out at Camp Hawkins. These groups did an excellent job with over 40 persons receiving Christ! Since that partnership has been happening over 130 persons have come to Christ and a new Hispanic church start is soon to happen!

<u>GBMB Ministries</u> - Several GBMB events took place in our region with <u>Disaster Relief Training happening in Toccoa</u> (30 persons certified), <u>Mobile Dental Clinics</u> happening in Clarkesville (three days of great ministry) and <u>SPARK Training</u> happening in Athens at Beech Haven BC. *Continued on next page....*

<u>Chattahoochee Mountain Fair Ministry</u> - This event was led and organized by several of our LBA associational leaders (<u>thanks Ashley Sharp and Chris Webb</u>) and touched many lives and many families. This is a long event happening over 8 days and our teams from both associations did great!

<u>Peru Missions Team</u> -- The last event happening just a few days ago was the sending of a team of 8 missionaries from our two associations to minister in Lima, Peru. These individuals did an incredible job of not only laying the groundwork for future ministry in Peru but also in leading 44 persons to Christ while there! <u>Rev. Keith Ivey, Rev. Doug Porter, Rev. Craig Ward. Rev. Graham Parris and Rev. Matthew Butler</u> were strong participants on that trip!
