- <u>Disaster Relief Ministry</u> Thanks to all who are currently responding to disaster relief needs here in our area, in the state of Georgia and in surrounding states like NC and SC! The needs are great and now is the time for you and I to respond. Thanks to Doug Porter (our moderator for Habersham Association) and to Chris Webb (moderator at Liberty Association) we have some ideas of ways we can respond now. Check out this edition of the newsletter for more info about some suggestions to minister in these needs.
- <u>Our September Mountain Fair Ministry</u> went well with many multiple church groups manning the family booth at the fair from our two associations of Habersham and Liberty. Several churches are reporting new visitors and members who they met during the Fair!
- <u>Peru Mission Teams</u> Just recently both our most recent teams returned from Lima, Peru having seen great results in ministering to the people with the first team seeing over 50 saved during their week and just recently the Bethlehem Medical/Children's Ministry Team seeing 103 saved during their week there! Previously we have seen 44 saved from the team from last October (2023) and another 60-70 saved from our Liberty Baptist Association team from last July! Stay tuned for more opportunities for mission teams to go to Peru. We know that Habersham Baptist, Level Grove Baptist, Bethlehem Baptist and Hills Crossing Baptist are currently planning to take church teams down for continued missions. How about you and your church as well? Let me know if you would like to take a team down there!

DISASTER RELIEF RESPONSE FOR OUR ASSOCIATION

With the arrival of Hurricane Helene in our region over these past weeks our churches have been working to respond to needs here in Georgia and in our neighboring states (NC, SC and TN). <u>Antioch Baptist (Pastor Chris Webb)</u> took up a large load of supplies to North Carolina to help with the needs there. As folks are asking now what can we do let me share two quick opportunities: 1. Pastor Doug Porter (from Habersham Baptist Church) has talked with our GA Baptist Disaster Relief Coordinator and the requests were for immediate chainsaw supplies (Chain bar oil, and Gas Treatment Oil—50 to 1 mix). Also requested was gift cards to use with the teams coming to work (Walmart, VIESA Money Cards). 2. Our associations have worked with a mission center in Mountain City, Tennessee which was hit hard by Helene. We have been asked to send supplies to their resupply area (in Morristown, TN) and then bring folks up after a few weeks to begin clean up and restoration. The needed items we can collect now would be bottled water, toilet paper, diapers, baby formula and hygiene products. Those things can be taken to Mt. Airy Baptist Church (832 Grandview Aveune, Mt. Airy, GA 30563). These will be taken to Morristown next week so please bring your items to the church quickly!
